- 1 1 vase, 3 long trumpet daffodils, any one variety, one colour
- 2 1 vase, 3 long trumpet daffodils, any one variety, multi-coloured
- 3 1 vase, 3 short trumpet daffodils, any one variety
- 4 1 vase, 5 blooms, 5 distinct varieties of daffodils
- 5 1 vase, 3 stems, white daffodils, any one variety
- 6 1 vase, 3 stems, dwarf daffodils, any one variety
- 7 1 vase, 3 stems, double daffodils, any one variety
- 8 1 vase, 3 stems, pheasant eye narcissi, any one variety
- 9 1 vase, 3 stems, multihead narcissi, any one variety

- 17 1 vase, 5 violas or violets or violettas
- 18 1 vase, 5 blooms, any colour, spring flowers, excluding classes 14-17
- 19 Blossom, 3 sprays, white, any one variety
- 20 Blossom, 3 sprays, any other colour, any one variety
- 21 1 vase, 3 stems of Hellebore, mixed or one variety

POT PLANTS

For outstanding exhibit in classes 22-26

- 22 Pot plant, or spring bulbs in flower, pot not to exceed 15 cm in diameter
- 23 Pot plant, foliage only, pot not to exceed 15 cm in diameter
- 24 Orchid, 1 pot, any variety
- 25 Bonsai, 1 pot
- 26 Pot plant, other

CORONATION CHALLENGE CUP
Presented by Mr Fluxton in 1953

For outstanding exhibit in classes 27-33

- 27 Arrangement of yellow flowers and foliage, not exceeding 45cm wide in any direction
- 28 Arrangement of orange flowers and foliage, not exceeding 45cm wide in any direction
- 29 Arrangement of either blue/purple/lilac, or combination of flowers and foliage, not exceeding 45cm wide in any direction

- 30 Arrangement of foliage only, not exceeding 60cm wide in any direction
- 31 Table Centre: 'Easter Celebrations', not exceeding 30cm by 30cm in any direction
- 32 Petite arrangement of spring flowers and foliage, not exceeding 25cm wide in any direction
- 33 Hanging basket as small or large as you like, providing you can display it on a table
