Show Regulations

Anything not provided for in these regulations will be dealt with by the Committee.

- 1. Exhibitors may enter <u>one</u> exhibit only per class.
- 2. Entry forms can be found in the Society's printed brochure, or can be obtained from the WHS web site (www.wolvercote.org/Horticultural/Horticultural.htm) or from the Show Co-ordinator (e-mail bee@benjon.co.uk; telephone 01865 316737)
- 3. Entry forms must be completed and delivered to the Show Co-ordinator, with the entry fee, during the week preceding the Show and **not later than** the preceding Friday evening. Please allow sufficient time for postal entries to arrive. Children's entries can be submitted on the morning of the Show.
- 4. You may request and send back your entry form via e-mail to the Show Co-ordinator. However, e-mail is not infallible, so please ensure that you have received confirmation of receipt. Fees for electronic entries can be paid on the morning of the Show.
- 5. All Shows take place in the Wolvercote Village Hall. Exhibits are to be brought to the Hall between <u>9.00a.m.</u> and <u>10.00a.m</u>. on the morning of the Show. Exhibitors must vacate the Hall by 10.15a.m., so please allow yourself sufficient time to set up your exhibits.
- 6. Judging will commence at 10.30a.m. No unauthorised person may be present while judging is taking place. The public is re-admitted from 2.00p.m.
- 7. Children's trophies will be presented at 3.30p.m. and they will then receive their prize money. Adult trophy presentations start at 4.00pm.
- 8. Would exhibitors please refrain from removing their exhibits until 15 minutes after the end of all trophy presentations.
- 9. Any protest should be lodged with the Chairman or the Show Co-ordinator on the day of the Show, accompanied by a fee of 50 pence. This fee will be returned if the protest is upheld.
- 10. The Committee reserve the right to inspect gardens and/or allotments of exhibitors, if deemed necessary.
- 11. The Committee will do all in its power to prevent loss or damage, but cannot be held responsible for such occurrences.
- 12. Entry fees are: 10 pence per exhibit for adult members; 20 pence for adult non-members; children free. Public entry at the door in the afternoon (from 2.00p.m.) is 30 pence. Refreshments will be available.
- 13. All trophies must be returned to the Show Co-ordinator <u>one month</u> before each Show. Cups may be engraved by winners, if desired.
