Awarded to the Exhibitor of the Year – defined as the person who has produced the most successful range of exhibits over all WHS Shows during the current year. This shall be determined from the records kept by the Show Secretary, using the following points system:

Winning a Cup or Trophy 4 points A First Place Certificate 3 points A Second Place Certificate 2 points A Third Place Certificate 1 point

The winner will retain the cup until the Autumn Show of the following year and may have the plinth engraved, at his/her own expense, if desired.
